**Village of Grand Beach
Proposed Charter Amendment to
Change Fiscal Year to July 1 Starting in
2025**

Shall Section 33 of the Revised Charter of the Village of Grand Beach be amended to provide that the Village's fiscal year shall begin on July 1 starting in the year 2025? The Village Charter Section 33 currently states that "The fiscal year of the village shall begin with the first day of November." The proposed amendment, if passed by the electors of the Village, would change the Village's fiscal year from beginning November 1 to a July 1 beginning date in 2025. The amendment, if approved, would read as follows:

Section 33. Beginning in 2025, the fiscal year of the village shall begin with the first day of July.

**New Buffalo Area Schools
Operating Millage Proposal**

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance. The remaining 1.875 mills are only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore such reductions.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in New Buffalo Area Schools, Berrien County, Michigan, be increased by 19.875 mills (\$19,875 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2025 to 2030, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 0.2037 mill is levied in 2025 is approximately \$196,276 and 18 mills are levied in 2026 is approximately \$18,548,151 (this would supplement and replace millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy)?
