To be used for emergency services equipment and general operating expenses for emergency services
One mill for six years
(includes renewal of .8803 mills, plus an increase of .1197 mills)

The last day to register in any manner other than in person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 19, 2026**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at the New Buffalo Township Clerk's office, located at 17425 Red Arrow Highway, New Buffalo, MI 49117 at the following times:

Regular Business hours:

Monday – Friday from 9 a.m. 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Saturday, October 31, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Election Day: Tuesday, November 3, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
