TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF NEW BUFFALO TOWNSHIP:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the Township of New Buffalo who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the New Buffalo Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms may be obtained at the office of the New Buffalo Township Clerk or at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the New Buffalo Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration with the New Buffalo Township Clerk or at www.expressSOS.com.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT A STATE PRIMARY ELECTION will be held in New Buffalo Township on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 4, 2026**, for the purpose of nominating the Governor, U.S. Senator, Representatives for U.S. Congress, State Senators, State Representatives, Local Offices, and to elect Precinct Delegates.

The last day to register in any manner other than in person with the local clerk is **Monday, July 20, 2026**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at the New Buffalo Township Clerk's office, located at 17425 Red Arrow Highway, New Buffalo, MI 49117 at the following times:

Regular Business hours:

Monday – Friday from 9 a.m. 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Saturday, August 1, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Election Day: Tuesday, August 6th from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The full text of the ballots may be obtained from the New Buffalo Township Clerk's Office, 17425 Red Arrow Highway, New Buffalo, MI 49117. A sample ballot may be viewed at mi.gov/vote.

Persons with special needs as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the Clerk's Office.
