To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the New Buffalo Township Clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
