**POSSIBLE REVOCATION OF SPECIAL LAND USE PERMITS  
FOR MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Township Board of New Buffalo Township will hold a special meeting and four public hearings on **June 22, 2026, at 5:00 p.m.** local time, at the Township Hall located at 17425 Red Arrow Highway, New Buffalo, Michigan, 49117 to consider the possible revocation of special land use approval for the following marijuana establishments:

- Mint Cannabis, 18300 W. US-12, New Buffalo
- Trapstars Outlet, 13964 Grand Ave., New Buffalo
- Refine New Buffalo, 19281 US-12, New Buffalo
- The Plug New Buffalo, 19015 US-12, New Buffalo

Revocation is being considered based on each establishment's alleged violations of state law or regulations, the Township's ordinances, or the special land use conditions. Upon written request, the Township will provide an electronic copy of the CRA complaints described above to the special land use permit holder at no charge.

At the public hearing, all establishment representatives and members of the public will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. Written comments may be submitted by mail, email (mhannon@newbuffalotownship.org), or in person until 4:00 p.m. on the date of the public hearing at the Township Hall. All written comments will be provided to members of the Township Board for consideration.
