NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

To the residents and property owners of the Township of New Buffalo, Berrien County, Michigan and any other interested persons:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following are amendments which were adopted by the New Buffalo Township Board at special meeting held on July 22, 2019.

Delete section 1C defining national holidays and 2A & B regarding discharge of fireworks on a national holiday.

Add new section 2:

No person shall ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks in the Township except during the following dates and times:

1. 11:00 a.m. on December 31<sup>st</sup> – 1:00 a.m. on January 1<sup>st</sup>
2. 11:00 a.m. – 11:45 p.m. on the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day
3. 11:00 a.m. – 11:45 p.m. on June 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>
4. 11:00 a.m. – 11:45 p.m. on July 5 if that date is a Friday or Saturday
5. 11:00 a.m. – 11:45 p.m. on the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day

Amend section 4. Violations, Fines and Penalties.

A violation results in a fine of \$1,000, of which \$500 of this fine must be remitted to the local law enforcement agency responsible for enforcing the ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after publication.
