## **CURFEW ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE HOURS THAT CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS MAY BE IN OR UPON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS, ALLEYS, OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN NEW BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, AND TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

## **NEW BUFFALO TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:**

- Section 1. No minor under the age of 18 years of shall be, or remain, in or upon the streets, alleys, highways or other public places in the Township of New Buffalo between the hours of 10 o'clock p.m. and 6 o'clock a.m. of the following day on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings; and between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. of the following day on Friday and Saturday evening, unless such minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody and control of such minor, or unless such minor is engaged in the performance of a duty or activity directed by such parent, guardian, or custodian.
- Section 2. No person shall assist, aid, abet, allow, permit or encourage any such minor as above defined to violate the provisions of this act.
- Section 3. Any minor as herein defined, or any other person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail or detention home for not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4.	This Ordinance shall be effective on the 22 <sup>nd</sup> day of August, 1970.
